Walk to school

MashaAllah, we have had a big number of children walking to school as part of our Walk to School Badges Travel Tracker! However, we would love to see more children be active and walk to school on a daily basis.

Remember, if a child walks, scoots or cycles to school for at least 10 minutes a minimum of 3 times per week; they will receive a badge. If they manage to receive 3 out of 4 badges in the month, they will get 10 Dojo points at the end of the month.

Update on Change in Academic Calendar

We have carefully reviewed the feedback we received from parents regarding the potential change to our academic calendar for the last 10 days of Ramadhaan. After evaluating the responses, we can confirm that the majority of our parents have voted to keep the calendar as it is.

Tax Free Childcare

You can get up to £500 every 3 months (up to £2,000 a year) for each of your children to help with the costs of childcare. This goes up to £1,000 every 3 months if a child is disabled (up to £4,000 a year).
